





Arthur Milner (1902–2004)

Arthur Milner grew up on the family farm near Leesburg. Following high school, Milner graduated from Wilmington College in 1924 and became an educator, legislator, farmer and leader in church civic and Masonic organizations. He was a teacher, coach, principal and superintendent in schools in Highland County as well as most surrounding counties. He spent eight years in Ohio House of Representatives and served on agriculture, finance, education and welfare committees. He helped revitalize the Highland County Fair and served on the Ohio Exposition Commission and is a member of the Ohio State Fair Hall of Fame. He was active in the Lions Club and was a member of the Masons.
