

Beverly D. Rhoads (1939-)

Beverly D. Rhoads began her working career at the Highland County District Library, then located in Scott House. In 1961, she moved to the second floor, then employed by Hillsboro City Schools as the Superintendent's secretary. In short order, she moved into the position of Clerk (Treasurer) and remained in that position until her retirement in 2005. That same year, she was elected to the Hillsboro School Board and has been reelected to that position every four years. In 2006, she also became a board member of Great Oaks Institute of Technology and Career Development. During her working career she received many awards, including OSBA Award of Achievement (15 times), OSBA Master Board Member Award, OASBO School Fiscal Officer Award and OSBA Southwest Regional Executive Committee (8 years). In addition, Beverly has been active in local organizations such as the Highland County Retired Teachers Association and the Rocky Fork Decorative Artists group.
